Articles should be written in good English conveying the meaning clearly, objectively and concisely. All the manuscripts will be peer reviewed.

Submission of Manuscript

The length of an article should not exceed 3,000 words in the case of full-length article and 750 words in the case of short communications. Each half-page table are illustration should be taken as equivalent to 200 words. It is desirable to submit manuscripts in the form of soft copy in a compact disk(CD)on MS Word Document(Times New Roman Font; pt 12;2.5cm margin on all sides using double line spacing throughout the manuscript).All the pages of the manuscript (including the tables)should be serially numbered The manuscript should be submitted to The Editor, Universal Journal of Research,Dr.R.V.Arts and Science College,Karamadai,Coimbatore-641 104,TamilNadu,India.E–Mail:

Full-length article should include Short title, Title, Names of Author/Author(s), Institution and Address with PIN (Postal) Code, Abstract (along with keywords), Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusion, Acknowledgement, References and Tables and Figures (if any).The short communications should have short title author(s) name and address followed by the text in the sequences as in full length paper with out forming sections. In addition to the above instructions, author(s)are also advised to consult the latest issue of the journal or browse the website www.greenvalley.edu.in for writing the paper. The peer-reviewed international journal (Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE)) format can be followed for Computer Applications while preparing the research article.

Author(s) are requested to suggest atleast 3 referees who are competent to review the article.

References

The reference citation should follow the order: Name(s) of author(s).year of publication (with in parentheses), periodical (title in abbreviations Italicized), Volume (bold), starting and ending pages of the paper. References to a book include name(s) of author(s), title, the edition, the Publisher, City of publication, Year of publication, page numbers. Manuscripts accepted but not yet published may be included among the references. Designate the journal followed by “in Press” (in parentheses).Information from manuscripts submitted but not yet accepted should be cited in the text as “Unpublished observations” (in parentheses).Papers with out a reference list will not be sent for peer review.

The author(s) should submit the following certificate along with the manuscript duly signed,'Certified that this article has not been published/accepted/submitted for publication in any other journal'.

Equations and Derivations

- Use italic for variables, bold for vectors and matrices, script for transforms, and sans serif for tensors.
- Use superscripts and subscripts in superior or inferior position;do not use raised and lowered fonts.
- Extend fraction bars under the entire length of the numerator.
- Use the “degree” symbol instead of superscript lowercase “o.”
- Use “exp”rather than”e”if the argument of an exponential is complicated or lengthy.
- Use of the Following to avoid ambiguity: parenthesis, brackets ,and braces, in that order{[()]}.
- Number the equations consecutively within the article, not within the section.
- Place equation number (in parentheses) to the right of the equation.
- Add one extra line above and below all displayed equations.

Units of Measurements

Measurements, length, height, weight and volume should be reported in metric units (meter, kilograms, or litre) or their decimal multiples. All haematologic and clinical chemistry measurements should be reported in the metric system in terms of the International Systems of Units (SI).Only SI units of measurement and dimensions and standard abbreviations should be used. Approved nomenclature must be used for all genes and proteins mentioned in the text, figure legends, and tables. Binomial names of organisms should be italicized.

Genotype names and symbols should always be italicized, but Phenotype, including name or symbol of the protein product of a gene, where this is well characterized should be roman.

Proof

The corresponding author will receive page proof. Corrected proof should be mailed within two or three days to the editorial office. Alterations of more than a minor nature cannot be accepted at this stage. No further proof will be sent.
